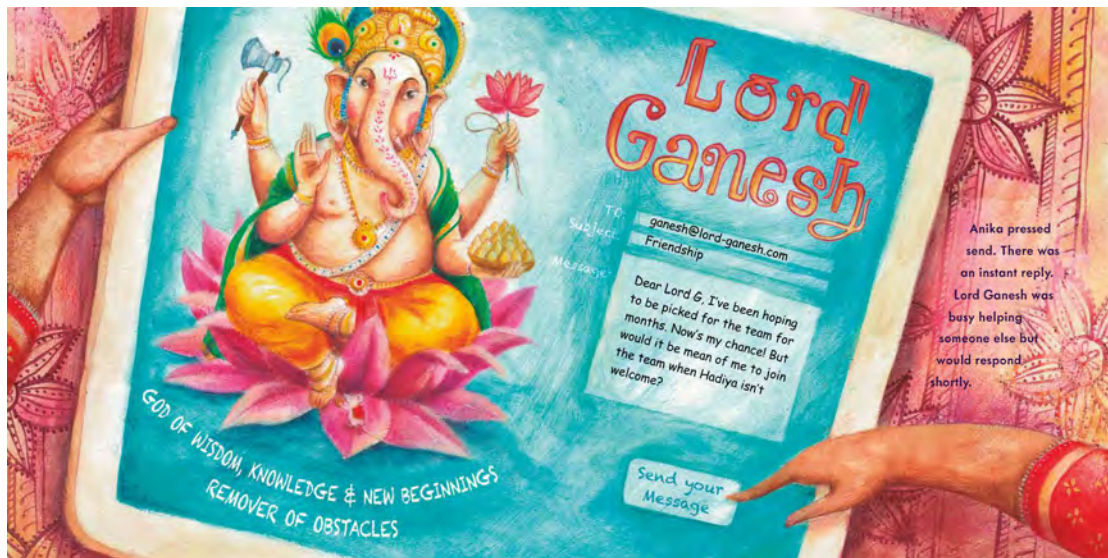


Commas

Reminder

Commas can be used to separate words, whether nouns or verbs, in a list or series. The conjunction 'and' is normally used between the last two words in the series: *I took my pencil case, lunchbox, PE kit and reading book to school with me.*
